### A fire engine can drive to my house.

The driveway and access roads are free of obstructions; at least 12 feet wide and with a 14- foot overhead clearance.

• A fire engine can turn around on my property / street.

**A:** If you hire someone, it can be listed as a cash expense. For example, hiring a tree service or landscaper for work such as removing hazardous plants, installing fire-resistant plants, creating a fuel break, or improving your home's fire resistance can all be included in your annual report.
