

SHASTA COUNTY

Defensible Space & Hazardous Vegetation Requirements

- ✓ Parcels 2-10 acres need 30ft. perimeter or site specific plan to reduce hazardous fuels
- ✓ Parcels 2 acres or less will need all hazardous fuels reduced within the entire parcel
- ✓ Adjacent property owners may need to remove hazardous vegetation to maintain 100 feet of defensible space around neighboring structures
- ✓ Must remove hazardous vegetation to the zone 2 standard of Public Resource Code 4291

Mowing. Cutting. Grazing. Trimming. Chipping.
