Wildfire safety is a shared responsibility. It starts on **your** property.

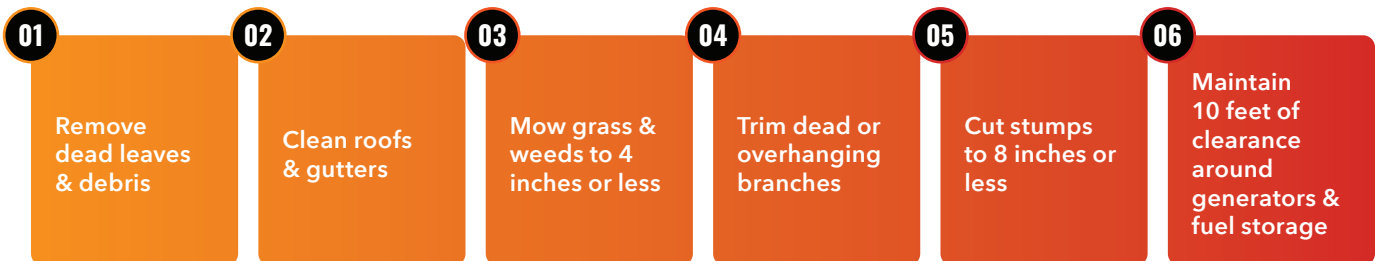
Clean Up Your Yard. Reduce Your Risk.

If you live in an unincorporated area on a parcel **10 acres or less**, Shasta County now requires you to reduce hazardous vegetation on your property to lower wildfire risk, protect homes, and support firefighter access.

What You Need to Do

- ✓ Think of this as routine yard maintenance—with real consequences.
- ✓ Maintain defensible space up to 30 feet from your property line.
- ✓ Up to 100 feet may be required to protect nearby structures.
